ESG & ACCESSIBILITY

ESG | Environmental, Social, and Governance

At the heart of Lost Shore's mission and values is the desire to generate a net positive impact on society. This is based on the principle that while we will not always be perfect, we will measure our impact, whether positive or not, and continue to find ways to improve.

- Our resort build has transformed the disused Craigpark Quarry into a 60-acre extensive grassland, with new wetland, woodland and grassland habitats and a substantial increase in biodiversity, including soil creation, re-profiling and an entirely new landscape.
- To power the site, we are using a green energy tariff. This means that all the electricity we use is produced from renewable sources.
- The Wavegarden Cove is the most energy-efficient technology in the sector - using less energy than a single chair lift at a ski resort.
- We are using a water source from the Union Canal, that after being processed with Wavegarden's Water Treatment Technology will be classed as drinkable water.
- When we occasionally empty the Cove for maintenance works, we will return clean water to the canal which will help oxygenate it.

Accessibility

Since its inception, Lost Shore Surf Resort has held inclusivity and accessibility as key guiding principles. Surfing has traditionally been a sport which has had many barriers to participation, both physical and perceived. Lost Shore is committed to identifying those barriers and removing them wherever possible.

- Accommodation 6 fully accessible Waterfront Lodges, one with a hoist for easier bed access.
- **Pathways** wide, gentle gradient tarmac road leading down to the main areas beside the wave pool.
- Buildings single storey buildings with shallow ramps, wheelchair accessibility, QR code ordering, gender neutral toilets, and baby change facilities.
- Indoor Heated Changing Area accessible showers, toilets, changing area, baby change facilities, family changing area and private cubicles.
- Waterfront Area smooth tarmac beach front with minimal gradient, access ramps, inclusive and para surfing sessions in collaboration with Inclusive Surfing Scotland.
- Commitment to Accessibility shared focus on removing physical and perceived barriers to surfing and an ongoing process to identify and improve accessibility areas.



PROTECTING OUR OCEANS

Ride, Learn, Conquer: Elevate Your Surfing With Lost Shore

Join us for a memorable school surf day at Lost Shore, where your pupils are in for an unforgettable experience. All they need are towels and swimsuits – we take care of the rest, providing top-notch surfboards and wetsuits. The day features a 90-minute coached surf session in the bay. Originally designed as a half-day, it can be extended upon request to a full day, complete with an extra 90-minute surf lesson. Get ready for a day filled with waves, fun, and learning.

SURF COURSE

Surf, Learn, Thrive: Master The Waves - Discover Yourself

Embark on a transformative 6-week journey with our comprehensive surfing course, guiding pupils from absolute beginners to mastering Lost Shore surf levels 1 and 2. Led by experienced instructors at an 8:1 ratio, students will enjoy six 90-minute lessons, with all necessary equipment provided—just bring a swimsuit and a towel.

Throughout the course, participants will not only hone their surfing skills, progressing from land-based lessons to catching waves in an upright position, but also acquire essential knowledge about the ocean and personal safety. Topics covered include understanding rip currents, the body's response to cold water, and the use of signal for communication.

Beyond the waves, this programme emphasises the identification of metacognitive skills needed to achieve surfing milestones. Students will engage in discussions on how these skills can be seamlessly transferred into their daily lives, whether navigating the classroom, workplace, or home environment.

UPGRADES

Enhance Your Experience: Would you like to add a surf lesson or a SurfSkate activity to your booking?

Surf Sessions: Why not take the chance to surf on Europe's largest inland surf pool and add on an additional surf lesson to your STEM learning experience. Our indoor heated changing rooms equipped with hairdryers and state-of-the art wetsuits, hoods and gloves ensure that everyone will stay warm at any time of the year. Our experienced instructors will guide pupils through a 90-minute lesson. Please note, adding a surf will change the timings of the day to ~1700 departure from Lost Shore and can only run in daylight hours.

The Surfskate Academy: Surfskating is an increasingly popular variation of skateboarding which replicates the experience of surfing a wave in the ocean, on dry land. Training on land becomes key to improving and perfecting your surfing technique but it can also serve as a basic introduction to surfing before entering the Cove. The Surfskate Academy offers sessions for surfskaters of all levels on an individual or group basis. All of the necessary equipment is included, so anyone can give it a go. Sessions last 60 mins and are subject to weather conditions.


ACCOMMODATION
