Opening in Edinburgh in Autumn 2024, Lost Shore will be the world's first inland surf resort, offering something for everyone.

Three times the size of Wembley football pitch, it will be Europe's largest wave pool and one of the most advanced on the planet! Powered by Wavegarden's Cove technology, we can generate up to 1,000 waves per hour, ensuring endless thrills for surfers of all levels! It is also the most sustainable solution in the industry, consuming less energy than a single chairlift at a ski resort and up to 10x less energy per wave than some other wave producing facilities. We also have the world's largest rental fleet of plant-based wetsuits specifically designed to keep you warm.

Set in extensive grounds with access to woodland and canal-sidewalks, the resort has 53 luxury accommodation units made up of Hilltop Lodges as well as Waterfront Pods and Lodges (6 fully accessible), sleeping up to 8 people, along with waterfront bar, café and restaurants showcasing Scotland's exciting food and drink scene. There is so much to do at the resort beyond surfing in the wave pool. - Minimum numbers are 8 and maximum numbers are 32 persons for surfing activities and 33 persons for educational experiences.
- Low Season: Nov – Mar | Mid-Season: Sep/ Oct & Apr/ May | High Season: Jun – Aug.
- 10% discount applied to all accommodation for school groups.
- Accommodation/ surfing prices are for mid-week only. Speak to a member of the team for weekend rates.
- All lodges must have an accompanying adult. Capacity numbers are 5 children and 1 adult for each 4 bedroom lodge.
- Food prices are for lunch time only – breakfast and dinner menus will be shared upon request.
- For camp prices, please contact the team.
- Weekend surf prices have an additional £5 net charge per person

- If you have never surfed before and have always assumed that Scotland was “just too cold for that nonsense”, then think again! Due to the impressive amount of design and technology that goes into a modern wetsuit, the surfer in the water is normally warmer than the walker on the beach!

- If you end up in a lesson or a session that is above your surfing ability and you are unable to surf it, we will ask you to leave the water for safety reasons so start low, build your ability and enjoy the process!

# ACCESSIBILITY

Lost Shore Surf Resort is a world class facility, which has held inclusivity and accessibility as key guiding principles, since its inception. Surfing has traditionally been a sport which has had many barriers to participation, both physical and perceived. We are committed to identify those barriers and removing them wherever possible:

- Parking - 16 blue badge parking spaces at the main entrance, along with coach/minibus spaces and EV charging.
- Accommodation - 6 fully DDA accessible Waterfront Lodges
- Pathways - wide, 250m, gentle gradient tarmac road leading down to the HUB Building. Mixed slopes and surfaces around the country park, with ongoing improvements.
- Buildings - single storey buildings with shallow ramps, wheelchair accessibility, QR code ordering, gender neutral toilets, accessible and baby change facilities.
- Changing Area - accessible showers, accessible toilets, accessible changing area, baby change facilities, family changing area and private cubicles.
- Waterfront Area - smooth tarmac beach front with minimal gradient, access ramps, inclusive and adaptive surfing sessions in collaboration with Inclusive Surfing Scotland.
- Commitment to Accessibility - shared focus on removing physical and perceived barriers to surfing and an ongoing process to identify and improve accessibility areas.





# GETTING HERE

Located in Ratho, we are 10 minutes from Edinburgh airport and less than 5 miles from Scotland's main motorway systems: M8, M9 and Edinburgh city bypass. We are located between Edinburgh (25 minutes' drive) and Glasgow (45 minutes' drive).

Our location is already synonymous with activity and family excursions. After all, our neighbour is Europe's largest indoor climbing arena, the EICA.

- **Free parking** is available and our main car park is a short 200m walk from our entrance building.
- **By Bus:** Services by Lothian bus service 70 to Ratho, Hallcroft Park then a 600m walk to Lost Shore along Hallcroft Path.
- **By Tram:** Catch the Edinburgh tram from central Edinburgh to The Gyle. Walk to the bus stop Gyle Centre (KF) and board the number 70 bus to Hallcroft Park. From here, walk 600m along Hallcroft Path to Lost Shore.
- **By Bike:** Cycle along the Union canal and take the stairs up to the EICA. Go past the car park and we're just around the corner. If arriving by E-Bike, we would advise leaving the cycle path at Ratho Marina and following the road to Hallcroft Park, to avoid the steep access at EICA from Tow Path.
